## Cadets Make a Splash Landing!

Cadets from 111 (Sunderland) Squadron have combined forces with the Royal Yachting Association to participate in a downed air-crew exercise.

The cadets, based at Thorney Close, flew missions over the course of the Easter weekend in their Flight Simulator which is based on the Canberra jet bomber.

Crews that were unfortunate enough to crash in water found themselves transported to Sunderland Marina and taken out on the water

for an introduction to power boating.

The downed crews were also given the opportunity to learn 'man overboard' scenarios that are practiced by lifeboat crews and rescue craft in the event of a water landing.

RYA Principal Alan Taylor said: "It was a good day out on the water for the cadets and it was obvious that they enjoyed the experience. It is always important to practice scenarios that can come up in real life, flying is not always

plain sailing!"

All cadets involved were awarded with their National Powerboat Certificate, Level 1 which is an internationally recognised award.

Cadet Corporal Nabeel Lahdan, 16, said: "The experience was amazing, it really allowed us to see the other side of the operation in the unfortunate times when aircraft do go down. "
